

Performance & Hospitality Requirements

Below are a standard set of requirements we ask from all our clients which ensures that both parties are clear on what's happening prior to and during a performance to make sure everything runs smoothly.

- Please factor in to your time scales we will need around 60 mins from arriving on-site to set up for an acoustic session. For an full band performance, we will need around 90 mins for set up/sound-check. In addition to the above, we will then around another 20/30 mins to get change into our performance outfits.
- We have a great deal of heavy equipment so sensible access to the venue will need to be provided.
- The venue will need to provide a safe and constant supply of electricity terminating in a **minimum** of 2 x 13 amp sockets on or near the stage area. Ideally we would prefer 4 sockets spread evenly across the performance area.
- We will require somewhere for us to get changed (for the both daytime and evening performances) and also somewhere to leave our belongings securely, so a private changing area will need to be organised for this. Please note that in the interests of safety and hygiene, toilets, portaloos or storerooms are **not** acceptable areas for the band to get ready in.
- Ideally, the band needs a performance area of approx. 4 metres across by 2.5 metres deep, although we can sometimes manage with a smaller space. We are happy to liaise with the venue when there are space limitations, but please be aware that the dimensions quoted above reflect the minimum comfortable working space.
- If you have are hiring a portable dance floor, can you please let us know as we need to ensure we have sufficient clearance from the dance floor to our performance area (min 1.5 metres). This so that we can set up all of our equipment and still have sufficient space to perform. It is the responsibility of the venue (or the hirer of the dance floor) to move it if is needed to accommodate the band.
- We do make a polite request for food and drinks to be made available to the band (6 of us) at your discretion. Happy to discuss and agree this.
